An ordinance amending the City of Springfield Municipal Code by amending Chapter 11, Section 221 entitled "Anti-Noise Regulations" and adding a new section 11-225 entitled "Public Conduct at a Special Event or Parade".

- 3.1 Discuss and possibly take action on a request from The Parks and Recreation Department to accept donations from the Historic Springfield Event Coordinators for the donation of various amenities to the dog park that is currently under construction at Garner Street Park. Donations include park benches, waste receptacles, dog waste stations, entry signage, and bricks. Estimated Value is \$12,073.96
- 3.2 Discuss and possibly take action on a request from The Parks and Recreation Department to accept a property donation to the Springfield Greenway. The Groth and Fentress families will donate a park bench as a memorial of Susan Groth Fentress. The family will fund all aspects including the concrete pad, bench, and plaque. Estimated value is \$1,800.00
