
- 1.0 Call to order 6:00 P.M.
- 2.0 Consent
- 2.1 Alderman Harris moved to approve a request from the Public Works Department to award the bid for a unit price contract for utility street repair and maintenance to Sessions Paving Co., Inc. in the amount of \$324,125. Funding for the contract would be from the Utilities and Public Works Department. The motion was seconded by Alderman Trotter and passed by a 5-0 roll call vote.
- 3.0 Administrative
- 3.1 Alderman Trotter moved to approve a proposal by Green Village Recycling for the curbside, single-stream collection and recycling of household waste at a rate of \$11.00 per month per household. The motion was seconded by Alderman Harris and passed by a 5-0 roll call vote.
- 3.2 MTAS presented the water & sewer rate study they prepared - no action was taken.

Mayor Schneider shared an invitation from Lippert Components (formerly known as JDak) to join them on April 14, 2018 to pick up trash around the city. She also reminded the board that City offices would be closed on Friday March 30, 2018 in observance of Good Friday.

City Manager, Gina Holt asked the board to think about how they wanted to handle the information they had received from MTAS going forward as far as the


rate structure, etc. She also advised that the RFP for the hydraulic study for the water system should go out in the next couple of weeks. She stated that she felt there would be more special meetings regarding the water and sewer systems and rates in the future.
